


## AMENDMENT NO. 001

This Amendment (the “Amendment”) made as of the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2020 (“Effective Date”) is to the Agreement by and between the Detroit Public Schools Community District (the “District”) and Detroit Rescue Mission Ministries (“Supplier”) dated on or around June 15, 2015, and any amendments hereto (collectively, the “Original Agreement”).

### STATEMENT OF AMENDMENT TO ORIGINAL AGREEMENT

1. Section C Scope of Service shall be amended with the following:

All in-person activities, whether school-based or in central offices, shall be conducted with the following guidelines, all in alignment with the most recent CDC guidance:

- Supplier shall require staff assigned to/placed in the District to receive a negative COVID-19 test within 14 days of returning to work for the District.
- Supplier shall provide staff placed in/assigned to the District with training that promotes behaviors to reduce the spread of the virus such as, but not limited to, staying home when sick, respiratory etiquette, and practicing hand hygiene (including hand washing with soap and water regularly).
- Staff placed in/assigned to the District by Supplier shall participate in daily temperature checks by utilizing temperature kiosks placed in various District locations.
- Staff placed in/assigned to the District by Supplier shall be required to affirm they are not experiencing Covid-19 symptoms prior to entering a building or office space by completing health screenings.
- Supplier shall provide all necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for staff placed in/assigned to District to perform their specific role. Face covering is required for all persons when in any District location.
- Staff placed in/assigned to the District shall comply with posted signage promoting social distancing and safe practices.
- Suppliers shall limit the sharing of equipment, supplies, and other items between staff placed in/assigned to the District or between schools.
- Supplier shall limit non-essential staff from visiting any District location.

2. If any provision of this Amendment is held to be void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions are considered to be severable and their enforceability is not affected or impaired in any way by reason of such law or holding.

3. The terms and conditions of the Original Agreement remain in effect except as otherwise stated herein. In the event that any provision of this Amendment conflicts with any of the provisions set forth in the Original Agreement, the provisions of this Amendment shall govern and control.

4. The Original Agreement and this Amendment constitute the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof; superseding all prior understandings, agreements, contracts or arrangements between the parties, whether oral or written.

5. This Amendment is incorporated by reference in, and is part of the Original Agreement. This Amendment need not be referenced in any instrument or document at any time referring to the Original Agreement, a reference to either the Original Agreement or the Amendment shall be deemed a reference to the Original Agreement, as modified hereby.


6. Capitalized terms defined in the Original Agreement and used in this Amendment shall have the respective meanings assigned to such terms in the Original Agreement, unless clearly otherwise defined in the Amendment.

7. This Amendment may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together constitute one and the same document.

8. The Parties further agree that a signature transmitted via facsimile or electronic mail shall be deemed original for all purposes hereunder.


